

PBGH Common Purchaser Agreement Principles

- Near-term transition to flexible and prospective, population-based payment to enable practices to transition to advanced primary care
- Removing payment barriers to the integration of mental health care for mildto-moderate conditions (to be determined)
- Resources to acquire data and information to manage patients care

- Payment that supports resources needed to avoid unnecessary and low-value care
- Payment to collect and transparently share patient-reported outcome and experience measures with purchasers and patients
- Payment models that promote and enable equitable access and outcomes
- Primary care should be equipped to leverage community and employer resources to address social determinants of health (SDOH)



RFI Approach

- Focus on provider-level **outcomes**
- Metrics requested will help us assess the quality-of-care practices are delivering to patients
- High-performing practices achieving 90th percentile NCQA PPO performance on common measures complete mandatory sections only
- We expect performance to improve over time and acknowledge not everyone can meet standards today
- Activities must be in place by the date of submission or clearly noted that it is a future activity that will be implemented on specific date noted in your response
- Intentionally flexible to respect regional and other differences in care delivery
