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## **Measure Set: Alignment with Attributes**

The Purchaser Business Group on Health's (PBGH) California Quality Collaborative (CQC) has articulated attributes of Advanced Primary Care, result in high quality, high value primary care with patients at the center of every interaction. To help identify practices having implemented these attributes, CQC utilized a multi stakeholder process to define a measure set focused on patient experience of care and health outcomes.

The Advanced Primary Care measure set is summarized in the table to the right. These were selected by CQC both due to a rich body of literature demonstrating that high performing primary care practices employ these measures and because they are nationally recognized and widely adopted.
