




What is CalHIVE BHI?

A 36-month quality improvement collaborative beginning in July 2023 that will focus on the integration of behavioral health services into primary care.

Goals:

- Define and implement an integration pathway for each participant aligned with their organizational objectives
- Increase access to behavioral health services within the primary care setting to support depression and substance abuse management.
- Improve behavioral health and chronic disease outcomes across key indicators (depression screening, response and remission, diabetes, etc.)






How are we supporting your organization?

Direct Funding

• Up to \$100,000 over 3 years, includes core and performance-based payments to support integration activities

Improvement Advising

- Regular support from CalHIVE BHI's team of experienced advisors
- Tailoring of learning events, assignments
- Curated resources



Integrated Technical Assistance

Learning Events

- Monthly learning webinar
- Monthly peer sharing webinar
- Annual convening

Data Insights

- Quarterly measurement data submitted




