How to Access the CFHA Listserv (Gaggle)

You have 2 options for how to send a message to Gaggle.

- Option 1
 - Login to the Gaggle website and send a message from the interface there.
- Option 2
 - Send an email directly from your own email inbox.
 - Email to cfha@gaggle.email to start a new thread, or reply directly to a listserv email you received.
 - Messages will go out to the entire listserv, which is made up of all our members
- Delivery settings can be modified to your needs without having to unsubscribe from the listserv. There are 3 options for delivery settings:
 - "Immediately" is the default delivery mode when added to Gaggle.
 - This will send every listserv message and response to your email inbox.
 - "Daily Digest" will send one email per day, with a summary of all of the topics that received messages that day.
 - Then you can click on any topics you are interested in to read the full message chain on Gaggle.
 - "Pause all messages" will stop any listserv messages from coming to your email inbox.
 - You can still participate in the listserv by going onto the Gaggle website.
- If you unsubscribe from Gaggle, you will no longer have access to the listserv.
 - This can always be changed in the future, but you would have to send CFHA a request to be re-added if they had unsubscribed previously.
