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Measure Set

The Purchaser Business Group on Health's (PBGH) Comprehensive Maternity Care Workgroup has articulated the attributes to define comprehensive maternity care which ensures high-quality, equitable maternal and infant health outcomes. To help identify hospitals and practices having implemented these attributes, PBGH utilized a multistakeholder process to define a measure set focused on equity, patient experience of care and health outcomes. These measures were selected based on their alignment with national measure sets and accreditation organizations and their ability to identify and evaluate high-performance in maternity care.

All measures will be required to be stratified by race, ethnicity and language (REaL) and sexual orientation and gender identity (SOGI) data where available. Measure Data/Impact Level
