

Comprehensive Maternity Care Measure Set

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Measure Set

The Purchaser Business Group on Health's (PBGH) Comprehensive Maternity Care Workgroup has articulated the attributes to define comprehensive maternity care which ensures high-quality, equitable maternal health outcomes. To identify hospitals and practices having implemented these attributes, PBGH utilized a multistakeholder process to define a measure set focused on equity, patient experience of care and health outcomes. These measures were selected based on their alignment with national measure sets and accreditation organizations and their ability to identify and evaluate high-performance in maternity care.

All measures will be required to be stratified by race, ethnicity and language (REaL) and sexual orientation and gender identity (SOGI) data where available.

Measure

1	NTSV C-section
2	Prenatal depression screening and follow-up & Postpartum depression screening and follow-up
3	Maternity care: postpartum follow-up and care coordination
4	Social need screening and intervention
5	Patient experience – <u>CAHPS</u> and <u>HCAHPS</u> for maternity population
6	Severe obstetric complications
7	% of Midwife deliveries
8	% of Maternity patients who used a doula

The midwifery and doula care measures are not yet part of a national measure set. Data specifications for these measures will be developed by PBGH members, and data collection will include both claims-based and manual data collection methods.
